## VILLAGE GREENS

As most villagers will be aware, a group of volunteers maintains our two village greens (High Street / Main Street and Goshun) with financial assistance for mower maintenance from the Parish Council. Other costs have traditionally been met as required through fundraising and donations from villagers. This year, unfortunately, we will have to buy a new mower, costing up to £400. This is in addition to the cost of the two brown bins for the clippings. The Parish Council have offered just £100. ## AISLABY, MIDDLETON AND WRELTON PARISH COUNCIL

### Extract from the Draft minutes of the February 16th meeting of the Parish Council.

Present; Cllrs Cooke (Chair), Firth, Lumley, Peirson, Pickering, Quinlan, Wilson and Wrench (Apologies for absence:Clr Halstead) Also present S Brown (Clerk) and 2 members of the public.

#### 5. Planning:-

a) The Council considered planning applications received from NYCC and Ryedale District Council since the publication of the agenda for the previous meeting [16/00080/HOUSE](#) Erection of 2 storey extension to side and detached double garage following demolition of existing single storey extension and detached garage. The Beech Villa, Wrelton Cliff Road, Wrelton YO18 8PJ Mrs V Clark

The Council supported this application but expressed concern that a hazardous material/contaminated land survey was not included with the application as the site was previously a filling station

b) To receive information regarding pending decisions and note the planning applications still under consideration by Ryedale District Council and NYCC outstanding; [15/01476/FUL](#) Erection of a replacement agricultural building to be used for lambing and storage following removal of existing building. | Broomfield House High Street To Bypass Wrelton Pickering YO18 8PF Mr Turnbull
