Fraudsters are setting up professional looking websites advertising various electrical goods and domestic appliances.

These goods are below market value and do not exist.

The website will state you can pay via card; however when the purchaser goes to pay, this option is not available and the payment must be made via bank transfer.

The websites have reviews and display the Trusted Shops Trustmark - all bogus.

Advice is clear:- Conduct online research in relation to the website, company name and the business address provided to identify any poor feedback or possible irregularities and always try to make the payment via PayPal or a credit card where you have some payment cover should you not receive your product.

If the item advertised seems too good to be true, then it probably is.

#### 5. Planning:-

[15/01476/FUL](#) Erection of a replacement agricultural building to be used for lambing and storage following removal of existing building. | Broomfield House High Street To Bypass Wrelton Pickering YO18 8PF Mr Turnbull

Council considered the application and supported the application

[15/01382/HOUSE](#) Erection of a single storey extension to rear elevation and a porch to front elevation. | Applegarth Wrelton Cliff Road Wrelton Pickering North Yorkshire YO18 8PJ Mr & Mrs Hanby

Council had no objection to the application

[NY/2015/0307/FUL](#) Change the use of the existing Pickering 1 Natural gas production well to a natural gas production and produced water reinjection well. The development includes well and wellsite modifications to facilitate the continued production of natural gas and the reinjection of produced water from the Kirkham Abbey formation into the Sherwood Sandstone formation, the drilling of up to four groundwater quality monitoring boreholes (each between 10M and 20M in depth) and wellsite restoration.(See website for full planning details).

The Council felt that some mentioned activity (both vehicular and operational) was less than specific but gave flexibility on behalf of Third Energy to expand actions which would normally require more stringent control had the activity been included in the application

The Council requests that full traffic monitoring including speed and volume of traffic be recorded and made public and possible provision of static Matrix signs be placed at Village access points
