A new plant survey has been undertaken in Beadale Wood. It was carried out during spring and summer 2016, by members of the Cleveland Naturalists. The last one was done five years ago by Ryedale Naturalists.

Another two species were found – figwort and wood vetch – to add to our list of our plants which are relatively uncommon in this area.

We have already recorded Herb Paris, Twayblade, Greater Butterfly Orchid, Globe Flower and yellow Star of Bethlehem.

The total number of species recorded was 114.

Some plants may not have appeared this year, or not been found; others were found, such as Lily of the Valley, which had leaves but didn't flower. Every season is different!

Our thanks to these volunteer Naturalists, and especially to Mags Walshaw, for their tremendous diligence and enthusiasm.

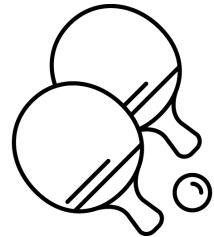
If it's Monday, it must be Table Tennis!
