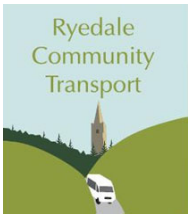
A message of appreciation.

RCT recruits volunteer drivers in the community who give their time to take people to medical appointments, shopping trips and to visit relatives among other things.

Volunteer drivers are registered with RCT, they are fully insured for the work they do and are DBS checked so passengers can have full confidence in them.

Drivers receive a mileage payment of 45 pence per mile from their passengers to cover the cost of running their cars on the journeys they undertake.
