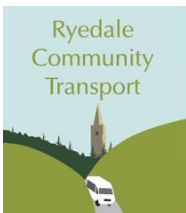

Following emails from two residents in the village this is a polite request to all dog owners to please clean up after your dog. One resident is particularly concerned about dog fouling on Wrelton Cliff Road on the way out of the village heading towards Aislaby - especially as a child has to cross there to reach the pavement on the other side. The other place is the path at the top of the village on Cropton Lane. Both these places have dog bins in close proximity. Thank you for your co-operation.

UPDATE: The representative from Ryedale Community Transport who contacted the Wrambler has offered to come to the village to answer any questions and explain what the service provides in more detail. If anyone is interested in this happening please let us know.



Ryedale Community Transport have contacted us to help raise awareness of their service and recruit more drivers in the villages west of Pickering towards Kirkbymoorside. RCT recruits volunteer drivers in the community who give their time to take people to medical appointments, shopping trips and to visit relatives among other things.

Volunteer drivers are registered with RCT, they are fully insured for the work they do and are DBS checked so passengers can have full confidence in them. Drivers receive a mileage payment of 45 pence per mile from their passengers to cover the cost of running their cars on the journeys they undertake. We can check to see if you qualify for any funding and connect you to quality, industry approved installers to carry out the work.

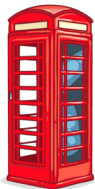
The Council is working in partnership with YES Energy Solutions (an award winning community interest company) to deliver the scheme.

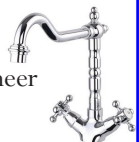
