From SFNY regarding the broadband upgrade to Wrelton.

*"You have previously been in touch with the SFNY programme and I am now emailing to let you know that your telephone cabinet has now been upgraded to fibre. To check what speed is available to you then please enter your telephone number into the availability checker at [www.dslchecker.bt.com/adsl/adslchecker.welcome](http://www.dslchecker.bt.com/adsl/adslchecker.welcome)  
The next steps will be to contact your service provider and place an order with them for fibre optic broadband.  
Just to let you know that not all service providers are offering fibre in your area and you may need to use a comparison website to see who is offering the service. Just enter your postcode into [www.broadbandchoices.co.uk](http://www.broadbandchoices.co.uk) and enter your postcode and press 'check availability' then select the 'fibre optic broadband' button."*

1. Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Cllr Lumley, Cllr Wood and Cllr Quinlan

### 5. Planning (and related items)

### 6. Finance

a) The Financial statement was received and reviewed.

7. The council reviewed the existing OS maps and their own research of existing rights of way. Two potential missing rights of way were identified as Dams Lane, Wrelton and track from Copice Lane Wrelton to Marton Lane. It was resolved to investigate further the procedure to log rights of way and to research further via local residents. The item will be kept on the agenda to review findings and progress.

### 8. General Maintenance

Current outstanding items to be included on the next agenda are:

a) Back lane, Wrelton right of way - status. – All requested details (Council Minutes) have been forwarded to Russ Varley (Definitive Map Officer) NYCC. Case to be sent to Secretary of State in 2017 as reported in previous minutes.

c) Cllr Quinlan reported that the stiles on the path from Wrelton to Sinnington are broken. Cllr Quinlan to report and progress.

9. Cllr Firth circulated the draft notice to advertise the grants available for parish projects. Cllr Firth to finalise and circulate for approval before been posted on parish notice boards, web site and newsletters.

10. Cllr Peirson reported receipt of the planning application for Wrelton Village Hall which will be added to agenda for the next meeting.

Cllr Peirson reported on the audit of the annual return.

The auditors PKF Littlejohn has requested clarification of the following items:

a) Change in fixed asset – Resolved as due to an error in the previous return which stated fixed assets which the council do not own.

b) Breakdown of the income received – Resolved as Precept, YLCA transparency funding, Interest and Ryedale District Council credit.

c) Omission of clerk signatory – Resolved as no clerk was available.

There was no fee due for the audit and the annual return has been certified.

11. The date of the next meeting was noted as Tuesday 17th October 2017 7:30pm.

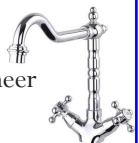
