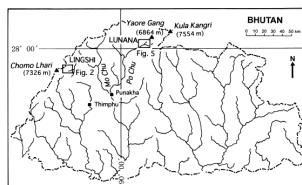
**HAPPY NEW YEAR 2018

In 2017 the planned upgrade of network connections to Wrelton finally happened to enable us to upgrade to Superfast Broadband.

We have heard of one or two households who have upgraded successfully but also the opposite - as can be seen below from Peter Anderson.

"As you know for many years BT have been promoting "fibre" and high speed broadband, with special offers just for us their special existing customers.

Then it happened, in September we finally got fibre in the village with the new cabinet next to our garden wall!

At the end of October we decided to upgrade as it would only cost us £6 per month more to move from "up to 17mbps" (actual 3.5) to potentially 52mbps.

On the 22nd December and after four orders and numerous phone calls and on-line conversations with BT we were promised action with a direct line to one of their connections team.

He contacted Openreach and was informed that we could not upgrade because we were on a different circuit to most of the village and Openreach did not intend to upgrade our circuit!"

Recently I was on Twitter and there was a complaint to Superfast North Yorkshire - who are responsible for dealing with the funding for the network upgrades - regarding a similar problem in Fadmoor.

I contacted SFNY and mentioned Peter's issues and they asked anyone who has such problems to contact them direct and they would look into it. They requested landline number and full address to info@superfastnorthyorkshire.co.uk
