VILLAGE HALL WIFI NETWORK

The WiFi installation, carried out by local company Beeline Broadband, is now complete and free WiFi is available at the village hall. The network is called “Beeline Wrelton VH” and the password is on the noticeboard in the downstairs room. The next stage of the process is to purchase a PC or laptop with the grant we were awarded by North Yorkshire County Council’s “Stronger Communities Fund”.

The purpose of the “Stronger Communities” fund is threefold:-

1. Reduced inequalities
 - Reducing health inequalities
 - Improving access to services or the removal of barriers
 - Influence and control – increasing civic participation
2. Improved social connectedness
 - Reducing loneliness and social isolation
 - Greater collective control – building increased community capital
3. Improved well-being
 - Emotional well-being
 - Physical well-being
 - Social well-being – supportive relationships (social capital)

At their next meeting (date tba) the Village Hall WiFi sub-committee will be discussing the next part of the process and looking at ways of promoting the service and its uses. They welcome any input or feedback from villagers as to how the service is been used or any ideas for the future. More details in next months Wrambler
