The Village Hall Committee are hoping to install a Community Access Defibrillator (CPAD) in the centre of the village.

The rural position of Wrelton makes response times by emergency services unpredictable. This is made more difficult during the tourist season by congestion especially on the A170. Clinical studies suggest that early use of a defibrillator can increase chances of survival from cardiac arrest by up to 50%.

During the holiday time our village population can increase by over 50% as the area attracts many people staying in self-catering establishments & B&B, caravanning & camping as well as cyclists, walkers, local dog walkers and children to the play area.

The defibrillator which is to be sited centrally in the village will be accessible to all these groups.

The cost of purchasing, installing and maintaining the defibrillator will be over £2,500

CPAD awareness sessions will be held and training offered to residents and also made available to anyone residing in the immediate area.

These events will be published in the Wrambler and on the village notice board.

The unit itself is very user friendly and no medical training is required. They are designed for use by members of the public.

We have been very lucky to receive £500 from the Parish Council and £500 from the Village Hall funds towards reaching our target. We are hoping that the remainder of the money will be raised from grants, fund raising events and individual contributions.
