### Appeal for Donations!

Last year there was an appeal in the village for items for the Food Bank in Pickering. This year a collection box will be in place from Saturday 1st December at the village hall.

The following items are needed: Tea, coffee, milk, dried pasta or rice, cereals, tinned foods e.g. corned beef, fish etc and tinned veg. or fruit, sugar, biscuits, jam, marmalade - anything which is non-perishable. Also required are essential non-food items such as toiletries and hygiene products.

"Christmas can be a difficult time of year for anyone, but for people living in poverty this time of year can present its own difficulties" - The Trussell Trust who run the foodbank in Malton (of which the Methodist Chapel in Pickering collection point is part of). As was stated last year:
