### PRIMITIVE METHODIST BAZAAR AT WRELTON

Beech Farm - June 10th/11th 1925

“A two days’ bazaar in connection with the Primitive Methodist Church was opened in Mr T. Turnbull’s granary at Wrelton, on Wednesday, by Mrs G. Stephenson, Appleton-le-Moors. The object was the raising of funds to erect a new Sunday School adjoining the chapel property. Mr Turnbull has very generously given the site on which the school is to be built. The bazaar was splendidly staged in the large buildings which had been choicely decorated. The Reverend Percival Myers presided over the opening ceremony and was accompanied on the platform by Mr and Mrs Stephenson (Appleton-le-Moors), Miss Stephenson, Miss L. Turnbull, Mr T. Turnbull, Mrs A. Welford, and Miss Saunders. Mrs Stephenson declared the bazaar open, and wished it every success. Mrs Coultman presented Mrs Stephenson with a lovely bouquet.
