As we need to book please contact either Jan (474469) or Bathsheba (473395) by September 15th to let us know you are coming.

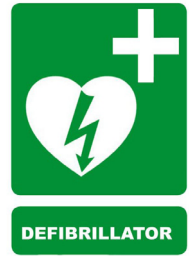
