*Apologies for the delay in getting in touch and, once again, thank you from all of us.*

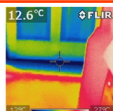

## THERMAL IMAGING CAMERA



LOTTERY FUNDED

Kirkbymoorside Environment Group (KMEG) have a thermal imaging camera available free of charge (donations accepted) to help residents identify and reduce heat loss through windows, doors, walls or roofs. KMEG volunteers are not trained advisors but have helped over 160 businesses and residents reduce heat loss - so saving money on their energy bills and reducing the carbon footprint of the area. The camera can be used to take pictures inside or outside your home with your permission, and these can be emailed or printed out for you.

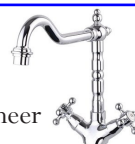
