A Message From the Village Hall Committee

We are pleased to announce the Village Hall will reopen to regular and one off bookings on 1st September with current government social distancing and cleaning regulations in place.

This will mean a reduced capacity for each of the rooms and a restriction on some of the activities that can take place. Unfortunately therefore some of our planned events such as music and theatre evenings as well as the Harvest supper this year cannot take place for the moment.

We have put extra measures in place to ensure the welfare of all users in terms of social distancing and hygiene including new signage and hand sanitiser dispensers.



There are two documents available (Risk assessment and Special conditions of Hire) and these should be read in conjunction with the usual conditions of hire posted on the Wrelton Village website.

The main implications are that:

1. The maximum number of people in each room is reduced to allow for social distancing - this will mean that the small meeting room will not be used other than as a way through to the kitchen – all meetings will take place in the main hall
2. We need users to follow a cleaning regime of the areas they use
3. The kitchen will only be used by agreement
4. The stage is not in use other than for storage by the woodcarvers group
5. Hall users will need to keep records of members of the group and inform the committee as well as track and trace system in the event of someone becoming unwell
6. The fabric chairs are not to be used
