Through Community First Yorkshire, York and North Yorkshire Local Enterprise Partnership and other partners in the region we recently had a feasibility study carried out (free of charge) at the Village Hall with the aim of reducing our carbon footprint primarily through solar PV and battery storage installations.

Phase 1 of the project has been completed and the results of the survey are available. The report is 115 pages and includes assessments of 26 village halls in the region. It also provides technical information on the solutions available and cost/ benefit projections to each village hall including Wreton. There is funding available in the form of grants from the Rural Community Energy Fund (RCEF) to support the installation of the technology should we decide to go ahead. Two video calls are planned for late January to talk through the report and answer questions. The report is available now if anyone would like to view it. Also, the Village Hall Committee are asking any villagers who may be interested in being involved in assisting with this project to get in touch. This is an ideal opportunity to contribute to the Village Hall without committing to being a trustee or Committee member - though we are always looking for new recruits!
