Countdown to the First Wrelton Village Show 2021 Sunday 8th August

Just a few last minute reminders:

Entry forms to be brought to the Village Hall between 4pm and 7pm on Friday 6th August with the appropriate fee (50p per entry with the exception of the Childrens' classes).

Remember one entry form per person. No late entries will be allowed.

Bottles for the tombola can be brought along on the Friday evening or given to any committee member before 6th August.

Entries are to be brought to the Village Hall between 8.30am and 10am on Sunday 8th August. Public viewing is between 2pm and 4pm on Sunday 8th August. Entries must be collected between 4pm and 5pm.

As space is very limited in our downstairs room we have made the decision this year not to offer refreshments but, as long as the weather is fine, people are very welcome to spill out into the play area and chat with family and friends.

It remains very important for us to respect and be considerate of those who are more vulnerable and who may wish to take a more cautious approach. So we are asking that when you bring your entry forms on the Friday evening and when you bring your entries on the Sunday morning, come to view the exhibits on the Sunday afternoon and collect your exhibits after the show that you wear a mask.

All the helpers will be wearing masks. To aid the flow and to minimise contact there will be a one-way system around the Hall. We hope that this will give you some confidence in joining in with this exciting village event.


