1. Apologies: Cllrs. Pickering (Illness). A. Robinson, C. Robinson.

2. There were no declarations of interest in item on the agenda.

3. a) Minutes of the previous meeting held on 20th July 2021 were approved.

4. There were no members of the public present.

8. General Maintenance/villages

a) Back lane Wrelton – Noted that date of 24Aug2021 was the final day for any further submissions in this long-running saga.

9. Reports from Councillors on delegated matters.

10. Cllr Quinlan pointed out the overgrown/dusty, muddy state of the already narrow footpath through Aislaby on the busy A170 and NYCCs reluctance to do any maintenance.

Discussion followed on the suggestion that the council pay a contractor to do the work as we do have funds available.

It was agreed that Cllr Peirson would contact Streetscene first, but if no further action ensued, then a private contractor would be approached.

Cllr Cooke reported that Ryedale District Council have a scheme whereby they supply a tree, at no cost, to the council and other public bodies. It was agreed that the council would like to take part and Cllr. Cooke was authorised to apply.

Cllr Baird reported that he had received complaints regarding the volume of traffic traveling through the village. He, and other Councillors, were at a bit of a loss as to what they could do about this.

11. It was noted that the date of the next ordinary meeting is the 21st September 2021.
