## Village Hall and Play Area News



The recent works on the playground at the Village Hall are now complete. We have replaced the swings (good to see the new ones been used a lot). The tunnel has been renovated and re-grassed and is now fully open again. Instead of spending upwards of £11k on replacing the zip wire, we asked the company who maintain it to repair it up to the standards expected from the RoSPA report. To this end the brake system, travel mechanism and wire have all been replaced and a new sheath fitted on the seat chain. This work cost £1000 + vat. We hope we can keep the zip wire going for another 5 years or so with these repairs. Our next RoSPA safety inspection is in September.



We recently obtained a price for replacing the existing fire door in the main hall. Looking at the image here the new door will have a fixed panel on the left and the opening door on the right of 1 metre. Specifications are: 'A' rated uPVC High performance Multi Chamber Frames (white), all frames internally beaded, low threshold with wheelchair ramp, high security locking system with thumbturn cylinder to inside (blank outside), 'SGG Planitherm' double glazed units (high performance glass with Solar Control and Low Heat Loss), 10 year installation Guarantee and manufacturers warranty.

We are also looking at re-landscaping to the outside of this door to have a better turning circle for wheelchair access.

The aim is that the new door will be compliant with our fire risk assessment that was carried out earlier this year. The new door will cost £2250 inc vat.

Thanks to your donations at our fundraising events, and community grants, we are able to carry out this essential work. Also, thanks to the members of the Village Hall Committee for organising the works.
