Option A: 3 pm Farm yard tour followed by field walk and talk finishing with the chance to watch the milking, about 1.5 hours

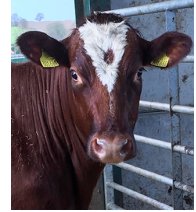
Option B: 4.30 pm 45 minute Farm yard tour and talk and chance to watch the milking

Additional Free sessions offered to Children and Young people in Wrelton Village Hall

At last, spring seems to be arriving and there is so much to look forward to. This is a welcome relief from the Covid pandemic and cost of living crisis which has made life hard. There are now a number of academic studies emerging which detail that the impact on children and young people is particularly acute and their emotional, social and developmental needs have been compromised by their not being able to get out and meet friends and even go to school or on outings sometimes.

At the recent Village Hall Committee meeting a proposal was unanimously passed to try to help children and young people in the area by offering the use of the village hall for free for one session per month from July to December 2023.

This is to enable new sessions for children, young people and their families to be set up, or to enable existing sessions to be extended at no extra cost. So if you have any ideas, such as breakfast clubs, after school clubs, youth cubs or one off play sessions which you would like to have considered please contact any member of the VH Committee to book your free time.

These proposals will be discussed at the next Village Hall Committee meeting for inclusion in additional bookings from July 2023.

Thumb turns to all fire exit doors fitted instead of the old break glass and key system.
