Once again, if anyone possesses any item or story, however small, which may be of interest and they are happy to see it become part of the archive, please get in touch.

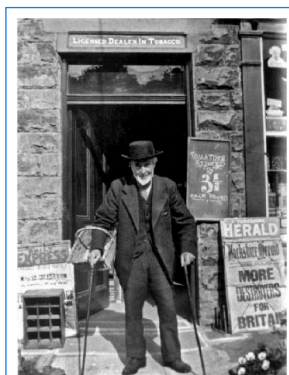
