### 4th Wrelton Village Show - Sunday 4th August 2.30pm-4pm

Just a few days left to finish off your entries before the Show on Sunday! Just a reminder about how to enter if you are new to the village or if you've never entered before.

Entry forms must be brought to the Village Hall on Friday 2nd August between 5pm and 7pm along with the appropriate fee. There is a 50p fee per entry except for the children's classes which are free. There can be no late entries. On Sunday 4th August entries can be brought to the Village Hall between 8.30am and 10am and judging will begin at 11am. The public viewing will be from 2.30pm until 4pm. There will be a brief trophy presentation at 4pm to the winners of each section and to the person who has gained the most points overall. After the trophy presentation entries can be removed and should be collected no later than 4.45pm.

We don't charge an entry fee for viewing the exhibits but this year there will be a donation bucket available. All proceeds from the Show will go towards the upkeep of the Village Hall.

Once again, we will have a book stall downstairs in the meeting room along with the ever popular bottle tombola. Any donations for the tombola can be brought to the Village Hall on the evening of the 2nd August between 5pm and 7pm or handed in on the day. If you haven't yet got a copy of the History of Wrelton copies will be available for £10 (cash only).
