Edited Report to the Aislaby, Middleton and Wrelton Parish Council regarding speed concerns on Wrelton High/ Main Street

Speed Concern – High Street, Wrelton (30mph) (RM24032)

Using the information provided on your original speed concern form, we have conducted further investigations and collected evidence through York and North Yorkshire Road Safety Partnership's Speed Management Protocol. Within North Yorkshire speed data is collected using specialist software which calculates average speeds for any given road over the period of a year. The data collected for High Street, Wrelton indicates the following:

All Day Average Speed: 16 Mph

All Day 85%ile Speed: 25 Mph

Reported Speed Related Accidents: 0

Based on the above information we have decided that High Street, Wrelton will face no further action at this time.

Our investigations are thorough, and all our outcomes are carefully considered.

The outcome of an investigation will remain in place for 3 years although will be monitored throughout this time.
