As over the past few years, Ryedale Woodcarvers are inviting villagers to join them on their annual bus trip, and this year we are going to Bradford. The coach will leave Wrelton at 8.30 am on Tuesday 24 June from outside the Buck Inn, and we will spend the morning at the award winning Industrial Museum, which features motor vehicles, wool weaving looms (in operation), reconstructions of a Mill Keepers House and back to back social housing, and much more.

In the afternoon the coach will transfer us to the Centenary Gardens area of the City Centre, where the City Heritage Trail includes the fully restored wool exchange, National Science and Media Museum, art galleries, and many other historic buildings including the City Hall.

On our return to Wrelton, Ellen and Chris at the Buck Inn have kindly offered to open specially and provide a 2/3 course meal which will need to be ordered in advance.

The cost of the trip will be £18 per person.
