RULES - WRELTON VILLAGE SHOW 2025 - Sunday 3rd August.

- 1. All exhibitors must be permanent residents of Wrelton or grandchildren (any age) of residents. N.B. There are no classes specifically for children under the age of 11 years but they may enter any class other than nos. 21, 27, 32, 38 and 45.
- 2. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or loss but all possible care will be taken to avoid such events.
- 3. No varieties are specified.
- 4. All jam jars and lids must be clean.
- 5. No vases or other display equipment is provided.
- 6. Judging will be carried out by independent people with relevant skills, knowledge and experience. Judges, whose decision shall be final, are empowered to open jars and cut cakes and vegetables. If entries are not of sufficient merit, or do not meet the criteria, judges may withhold prizes.
- 7. All entries must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor. **NB Exhibits previously** entered will not be allowed.
- 8. Each exhibitor may enter only one exhibit per class.
- 9. A fee of 50p is payable for each exhibit (**including 11-16 year olds**). Entries by children under 11 years are free.
- 10. Entry forms and fees must be submitted at the Village Hall between 5pm and7pm on Friday 1st August. No late entries will be accepted.
- 11. Exhibits should be brought to the Village Hall with the appropriate entry cards between 9am and 10am on the day of the show.
- 12. Judging will commence at 11am and is closed to all exhibitors. The hall will reopen for public viewing between 2.30pm and 4pm. Exhibits must not be removed until after the cup presentation at 4pm and no later than 5pm.
- 13. Certificates and points will be awarded in Sections 1 6 for 1st (3 points) 2nd (2 points) and 3rd (1 point) with trophies awarded to Section 1 6 winners who have gained most points. A shield will be awarded to the person in the 11-16 year old age group who has gained the most overall points in those specific classes.

At 4pm all section winners' trophies and the 11-16 year old shield will be presented, along with the Beech Farm Cottages' trophy, which will be awarded to the person who has gained the most points across all sections.

Bottle tombola prizes can be brought to the Village Hall on the evening of 1st August between 5pm and 7pm or given to a committee member beforehand.
