Audrey Parker passed away peacefully early morning on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> November. She was 95 years old and had moved into Omega Barn Carehome earlier this year.



From her son, Andrew:

"Mum moved from Norfolk to Wrelton in 1997. She worked as a paid guide at Castle Howard from 1998 until around 2005. She was in a local poetry group. They met monthly at each others' homes and enjoyed choosing, reading and discussing all sorts of poems.

Up until the last few years, Mum enjoyed being an active member of the village community, walking in the countryside, and tending her garden.

She had many good friends in and around the village and loved living in Wrelton."

The funeral has been arranged for Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December at Scarborough Crematorium, Woodlands Road, Scarborough, to take place at 1p.m.
