To attempt to reduce the field runoff onto the footpath on the A170 from 'Shoulder of Mutton' to New Lane, the two bottom strips of the field have been ploughed east-west instead of north-south by the new farm manager, James, as requested by the PC.

He has also joined the Parish Council so we hope that our suggestion works. Situation to be monitored!

The installation of the Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) on the A170 into Aislaby proceeds at lightning pace - the pole to which it will be fastened has been placed in the hole that was dug 6 months ago!

Broken/rotten stiles on the footpath from the village over to Sinnington have been reported to North Yorkshire Council, and those reports acknowledged. 'Paths' (NYC) have confirmed that all are the responsibility of the landowners to repair. They have been in touch with those landowners, two of whom have responded in the affirmative. Hopefully the third will also reply positively so that by next major walking season, all will be safe to use.
