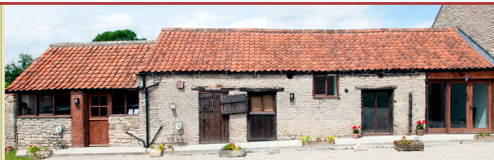

1. Hopefully residents have noticed the new speed warning sign (VAS) installed on the A170 near the bus stop in Aislaby. Comments to the Parish Council welcome. Further speed reduction measures (such as the installation of 'village entry gates' as at Snainton) are being discussed.
2. The Parish Council is in process of applying for the siting of an additional dog-waste bin near to (but not next to!!) the bench on Goshen.
3. Hopefully residents have noticed a huge improvement in the lack of mud-deposition on the footpath to the west of New Lane Aislaby despite this Winter/Spring's heavy rains. Down to the efforts of the Parish Council and co-operation of the landowners of the field.
