## Arthur Strickson - 1938 - 2026

The funeral of Arthur took place on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April at Middleton Church and was well attended by family, friends and neighbours from the village.

During the tribute we learnt Arthur had joined the Military Police as a young man before joining Nottinghamshire Police Force. He worked in various areas of policing and reached the position of Inspector. Arthur moved to Wrelton with his wife June in 1992 and soon immersed himself in village life. When John Pickersgill retired from the chair of the Village Hall Committee in 1996, after almost 20 years in post, Arthur stepped into the breach. He was chairman from 1996 until 2003 and during his time the Hall had a major three year refurbishment which much improved the amenities provided. Arthur continued to support the Village Hall after he retired from the committee producing two historical maps of the village to boost Village Hall funds and was a regular attendee at fundraising events. Arthur was an Honorary Member of Vale of Pickering Art Club and painted many local scenes. He was also a supporter of the British Legion and other organisations in the area. He was always generous with his time and will be sorely missed in the village.
