Update From the Parish Council

- The fixing of the new bin on Goshen to the speed limit pole on the north side was deliberately chosen, despite its proximity to the bench, on safety grounds. Anyone using the bin, although they may see/hear vehicles approaching in either direction, cannot be seen by those drivers, some of whom travel at excessive speed, if placed on the south side pole. Someone moved the bin from its original site to the south side, but we have now replaced it in its original position and would appreciate it not being moved again.
- There has been a great increase in dog poo not being picked by owners. As this matches the tourist season we would appreciate it if owners of holiday accommodation particularly would remind visitors that other people walk footpaths and the presence of grass underfoot does not mean that it can be left. Perhaps a note of the location of dog waste bins in the villages would be appropriate information to be provided by holiday home owners to visitors.

Wayside - a message from Mark Goodson

Dear Wreltonians,

You will have no doubt heard by now that back in May, after 50 years of ownership by the Goodson family, Wayside has been sold to another Caravan Park operator, namely the Flower of May who are based in Lebbeston, Scarborough.



This decision was not, by any means, taken lightly. However, with my co-director Trevor Jones deciding to retire after working for the company for 34 years and then our landscaper and plantsman Chris Bailey also deciding to retire (after 12 years) maybe I was being told something !

Therefore, after a long lunchtime meeting in the pub we decided to let go of the reins and allow another incumbent to take Wayside to the next stage !

Although I didn't live locally and so couldn't really feature in village life outside work, both Trevor and I had the philosophy that we wanted the business, as an entity, to be part of Wrelton life. I hope we succeeded to some extent, in support for repairs to the village playground, supplying a mower to cut the village green and contributions to the annual village show.

During my fifteen years running Wayside, I got to know many of the village dog walkers as they used the park as part of a circuit (especially after we had completed the lakes development) . They always updated us on what was happening in the village and on many occasions informed us of leaks that had occurred on the park which at the time we were unaware of !!

Whilst writing , I would like to thank the Parish Council for their support for a number of projects we carried out over the years, especially the development of the lakes area back in 2013. It was much appreciated. Finally, I would like to wish all Wreltonians and the village itself, all the very best for the future.
